I. Service Expectations:

You must document your service hours each semester after becoming a new member of NHS. Failure to complete the required service hours by the end of each semester will result in inactive membership placement. Inactive members will not be recognized at graduation. You must maintain a minimum level of service equivalent to a total of 16 NHS sponsored hours for each year you are a member of NHS. This is a National mandatory requirement to be a member of NHS and your membership will be revoked if you fail to fulfill these requirements.

II. Scholarship:

You will need a 3.7 cumulative weighted GPA to apply to the Rolling Meadows Chapter of the National Honor Society. In addition, each semester you are a member of NHS, you must maintain at least a 3.3 GPA. Failure to maintain these academic standards will result in the revocation of your membership in the National Honor Society or placement on the inactive membership list.

III. Character:

NHS will follow discipline policies established in the school code. All NHS members are expected to show academic honesty and follow school academic and behavior policies. Failure to do so may result in withdrawal from the organization or placement on the inactive membership list.

National Honor Society Agreements:

If the Faculty Committee, after reviewing your application, recommends that you should be accepted for membership in the National Honor Society, you will need to agree to the following statements. In order for your application to be reviewed, you will need to select yes below to the following statements.

1. I agree to pay a \$10.00, one time membership fee (you will pay after being accepted). Your membership will include a National Honor Society T-Shirt to be worn at events.

- 2. I agree to participate in NHS group service projects or individual service projects. NHS sponsors Blood Drives, members serve as mentors and peer tutors to underclassmen and supports all RMHS events. NHS members are expected to participate.
- 3. I agree to accumulate at least 8 hours devoted to service projects per academic semester (16 total for the year), as well as attend all mandatory NHS meetings throughout the year. Students must contribute to service at Rolling Meadows High School. A minimum of 4 service hours during the school year must be completed at RMHS. All service hours must be approved by the NHS Sponsor. Babysitting, shoveling the driveway, helping someone clean a garage and other neighborly tasks are NOT service hours. These are considered being kind and helpful. Your hours for this WILL NOT be approved. Always check in with Mrs. Snyder to verify that service will be approved before you participate in the task.
- 4. I agree to join the NHS Remind group and to read all emails and updates distributed by the NHS Sponsor or NHS Board Members. You may also follow our Twitter and Instagram accounts but this is not required.
- 5. I attest to the fact that my cumulative grade point average, as of the end of Semester 2 or August 11th 2022, meets or exceeds the scholarship requirement of 3.7 on a weighted scale.
